The Clark County Health Department uses data and facts to determine policy and with all decision making. This has been true from the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. The local health officer orders restricting business operations and capacities have been a tool to help control the spread of COVID-19 over several weeks.

Based on the review of our current data, we are experiencing a downward trend of COVID-19 infections in Clark County, therefore we will not be reissuing the past local restrictions on restaurants or bars at this time. We will continue to monitor data trends as we mitigate this public health emergency. We encourage everyone to be vigilant, stay safe, and consider those who are most vulnerable to COVID-19. Our ability to work together on these strategies will contribute to the return to normalcy that we all strive to achieve.
