

Acceptable Required Forms of Identification to Obtain a Birth Certificate

Primary Acceptable Identification: All Documents Must Be Current and Valid

- 1) Valid Driver's License
- 2) Military ID
- 3) State ID Card
- 4) Valid Passport
- 5) Department of Correction ID, issued within past six months
- 6) School ID, with signature or photo
- 7) Court Order (must order local health dept. to release record to person named on record)

Secondary Documentation: Two or More Required From Below List (1 Must Contain Signature)

- 1) Employment ID with signature, photo, date of employment or employer address
- 2) Bankcard with signature (not credit cards) or personal check with current information
- 3) Voter Registration Card with signature
- 4) Vehicle Registration with signature
- 5) Vehicle Registration with signature
- 6) Previous year's tax return with signature and social security number
- 7) Welfare, Food Stamp or WIC ID cards
- 8) Probation documents or statement from Probation Officer on letterhead, including person's name and date of birth
- 9) Letter from BMV or Social Security Administration that shows individuals name and date of birth
- 10) Signed leases or loan agreements
- 11) Expired driver's license
- 12) Club membership card with signature or photo
- 13) Gun permit with signature
- 14) Social Security Card
